In accordance with Act 603 of 2003 and Act 397 of 2009:

A child's education is a responsibility shared by the Bryant School District and its families during the entire time a child attends its schools. To support the goal of educating all students effectively, the Bryant School District and parents/guardians must work as knowledgeable partners.

Parent/guardians in the Bryant School District are diverse in culture, language and needs, and they are an integral component of the District's ability to provide for the educational successes of the children.

Hurricane Creek Elementary School believes that engaging parents/guardians in their children's education is essential to improving student achievement and the actual parent guardian involvement must be supported and promoted in all of its educational endeavors. The purpose of Act 603 of 2003 requires a public school to create a parental involvement plan. The Arkansas Department of Education recognizes the shared responsibility of the school and family during the time the child spends in school. Engaging parents is essential to improving student achievement. In addition, Act 397 of 2009 requires a public school to help parents assist students by providing instruction to a parent on how to incorporate developmentally appropriate learning activities in the home environment.

The purpose of Act 603 is to ensure that each public school implements a parental involvement plan. It is not the intention of the law for districts or schools with existing programs to create new programs but rather an opportunity to maintain and enhance the existing programs.

Parent/Guardian Involvement Program Guidelines

The Parent/Guardian Program at Hurricane Creek Elementary School shall:

1. Involve parent/guardians of student in grades K-5 in a variety of roles
2. Be comprehensive and coordinated
3. Recognize that communication between the home and the School should be regular, two way and meaningful.

Family Involvement:

To encourage communication with parents/guardians, **Hurricane Creek Elementary School** shall survey parents annually to determine options for their becoming involved in the school and in their children's total educational program. (Attachment A) The school shall also prepare brochures describing:

- The school's parent/guardian involvement program
- The recommended roles of the parents/guardians, student, teachers, and school
- A system to permit parents/guardians and teachers to communicate in a regular, two-way and meaningful manner with their children's teachers and their children's principals.
- The school's address and contact information

Recommended Roles:

The recommended roles of PARENTS/GUARDIANS are as follows:

- Communicate with faculty and staff
- Be an active member in school activities and functions
- Offer assistance to your children to ensure academic success

The recommended roles of STUDENTS are as follows:

- Be active and engaged learners in the classroom and at home
- Take responsibility for actions and education
- Obey classroom and school rules

The recommended roles of TEACHERS are as follows:

- Effectively communicate with parent/guardians
- Effectively communicate with students
- Provide an open atmosphere for successful learning
- Provide parents/guardians with up-to date progress on student achievement and behavior
- Attend professional growth opportunities

The recommended role of **HURRICANE CREEK ELEMENTARY SCHOOL** is as follows:

- Provide parents/guardians with opportunities to be involved in their children's education
- Provide parents/guardians with opportunities to be involved in school activities and functions, including family nights with activities and suggestions to help parents assist in their child's learning
- Facilitate communication between teachers and parents/guardians.

The Bryant School District will require (2) two hours of staff development for elementary teachers to enhance the understanding of effective parenting every four years. These two hours may be included in the teacher's required (60) sixty hours of staff development required by the state. The district will provide (2) two hours of staff development.

Hurricane Creek Elementary School will annually review and update the parental involvement plan and submit to the Department of Education as part of the Bryant School District's Parental Involvement Plan.
